The Arabian Horse Show "A" of El Jadida is organized by the "Association du Salon du Cheval" (ASC) in collaboration with the Royal Moroccan Arabian Horse Breeders Association (ARMECPSA), with the "Société Royale d'Encouragement du Cheval" (SOREC) and with the Arabian Horse Organization (AHO). It is recognized by the ECAHO, with which it is affiliated, with the application of the current regulations of the European Commission of Arab Horse Competitions.

General conditions

1. Entry conditions

The Arabian Horse Show "A" of El Jadida is open to Arabian horses registered in any WAHO recognized stud-book by the closing date of entries, having obtained one of the following qualifications in 2019, 2018 or 2017:

- 1st to 5th during the Shows "A" or "B"
- 1st to 5th during the national championship, C National, C International and C European Show,
- 1st and 2nd during the specific original show
- 1st to 5th of any AHO Show

As the number of demand for participation is high, and in order to ensure a balance between foreign Exhibitors, a quota by country will be fixed, by the closing date of entries which is September 30, 2019.

A committee of selection will give the final decision on the horses that were retained.

It is highly recommended that the participants interested by show "A" send their engagement form online (www.eljadidashow.com) or, by mail at : secretary@eljadidashow.com .

The sheet form must be duly signed and accompanied by a copy of the horse's passport.

The exhibitors are informed that the organizing committee of the show will respect the following agenda:

- Opening date of entries: August 19, 2019
- Closing date of entries: September 30, 2019
- Confirmation to exhibitors: October 01, 2019

2. Special conditions

***Competitors from all countries (with the exception of Spain and Portugal).**

The owner of each horse selected to participate in Show "A" in El Jadida 2019 will receive a support allowance of 2,500 euros per horse (two thousand five hundred euros) as a contribution to the cost of transporting registered horses and Personal expenses related to the stay.

The organizers will not pay any additional costs or expenses incurred by participants.

*** Competitors from Spain and Portugal.**

The owner of each horse selected to participate in the International Show of El Jadida 2019, from Spain or Portugal, will receive a support allowance of 2,000 euros per horse (two thousand euros) as a contribution to transport costs registered horses and personal expenses related to the stay.

The allowances shall be paid by bank transfer to the owners of the participating horses or their duly authorized representatives (handwritten certificate signed by the principal) immediately after confirmation by the competent authorities of Morocco of the re-export of these horses.

This allowance will be reduced to 500 euros per horse (one five hundred euros) in the event that the Association of the Salon du Cheval takes care of the carriage of horses.

The organizers of the Show " A " will not pay any additional costs or expenses incurred by the participants.

3. Engagements

The engagements of the horses are free, they must be instructed:

- One copy per horse, on which the name of the presenter must be indicated in capital letters and must be

signed by the owner of the horse, and accompanied by the documents indicated below:

- a. The copy of the identification booklet or the passport of the horse engaged,
- b. The certificate of vaccination against equine influenza,
- c. A copy of the presenter's passport or identity card.

Failing this, the organizers will not accept the commitment.

No changes in ownership of the horses will be taken into consideration after the closing date of entries.

4. Responsibility

The show organizing committee declines all responsibility concerning any accident, material damage, disease or any damage caused to and by a third party on the show arena and in the area of the Salon.

The signing of the enrolment form engages the owner's civil and penal liability.

5. Classes

Class 1 Fillies 1 year born in 2018

Class 6 A Colts 1 year born in 2018

Class 2 Fillies 2 years born in 2017

Class 7 Colts 2 years born in 2017

Class 3 Fillies 3 years born in 2016

Class 8 Colts 3 years born in 2016

Class 4 Mares 4 to 6 years old

Class 9 Stallions 4 to 6 years old

Class 5 Mares 7 years old & older

Class 10 Stallions 7 years old & older

6. Judging system:

Horses will be individually judged standing, walking and trotting. Each judge will assign a score from 10 to 20 points for the following criteria:

- . Note 10 to 20 for the type.
- . Note 10 to 20 for the head and neck.
- . Note 10 to 20 for the body and top line.
- . Note 10 to 20 for the legs.
- . Note 10 to 20 for the movements.

The half point system is applicable.

7. Regulation "open" championship:

The first three horses in each category will be qualified to compete in their respective championship provided there are at least five participants in the class. Otherwise only the two first of the class will qualify to participate in their championship. The Gold, Silver and Bronze Champions may be selected by the Judges from any of the qualified horses in each category participating in the championships.

Horses qualified to participate in the Championships will be judged comparatively by the entire jury of the Show.

-Rule for Yearlings, Juniors and Seniors Championships

-A horse cited for the Gold Medal by a judge gets 4 points.

-A horse cited for the Silver Medal by a judge gets 2 points.

-A horse cited for the Bronze Medal by a judge gets 1 point.

- Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the most votes for Gold Medal Champion. In case of an equal amount of vote for Gold Medal Champion, the Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the highest number of championships points.
- Silver Medal The quoted horse with the highest number of points after the first.
- Bronze Medal The quoted horse with the highest number of points after the second.

8. Rule in case of tie

1 - Rules in case of tie in the qualifying classes

The best place is given to the horse that has the highest points for the type. If there are still ties, the best place is assigned to the horse with the highest points for the paces. If the tie cannot yet be determined, one of the judges chosen by lot must indicate his preference.

2 - Rules in case of tie in the Championships

The best place is given to the horse with the highest grade in the class. If there are still ties, the same rule as for the qualifying classes will be applied.

All Gold Champions will be subject to blood and / or urine samples for doping control. However, if the DC deems it necessary, he may have any other horse engaged in the competition taken for an anti-doping control.

9. Handlers

The handlers have to be more **than 16 years old**, dressed **in an elegant outfit**, without any brand or distinct sign and must be in possession of their ECAHO permit; the disciplinary committee will have the right to refuse the entry to the showground to any person not respecting the policy. The Disciplinary committee can also refuse the participation of any horse disturbed or having a major or characterized sanitary problem. Any disrespectful behaviour and any disobedience toward the officials might lead to the elimination of a horse, whatever its range might be. Only one person is accepted to show a horse to the judges at the show ring.

10. Veterinary check

Every horse is subject to a veterinary check before its entrance to the “Salon du cheval d’El Jadida” from October 13th to 15th 2019.

11. Numbers

Numbers will be assigned to the handlers after the veterinary control and DC check on October 15, 2019 from show secretary at the show ground from 08:00 am to 12:00pm.

The horses have to be accompanied by their identification and sanitary documents.

Specific conditions

1. Arrival and departure of horses

The horses must arrive at the latest on October the 13th, 2019 before 4:00pm and will have to leave on October the 18th, 2019 from 10:00am.

Food is provided by each owner; of the fodder may be available on site.

2. Stables

A zone of boxes with litter will be reserved for the housing of the horses, drinking water points as well as shower spaces will be arranged.

A day and night security service will be provided, it is recommended to each person authorized to enter the stables area, to bring his badge of access. No derogation will be granted to the offender. All safety instructions must be observed.

Equipment

1. Qualifying classes:

- Winners: gifts, plaque and ribbon.
- 2nd place: plaque and ribbon.
- 3rd to 5th place: ribbon.

2. Championships:

- Special Trophies,
- Pieces of art
- Plates and ribbons.

Divers

1. Claims

Any complaint may be filed in writing to the Disciplinary Committee, at the latest one hour after the alleged infringement.

Each claim must be accompanied by an amount equivalent to 200 Euros in cash.

2. Doctor, Veterinarian, Farrier,

The medical and veterinary care and the services of farrier are the exclusive charge of each participant.

3. Insurance

All participants must have their personal insurance valid. The horses and equipment remain under their care and responsibility for the duration of both the Show A and the El Jadida Horse Show.

4. Customs formalities:

Each participant must take care personally of the transport of his horses and of the expenses inherent in the administrative expenses.

G – Accommodations

Participants who are definitely selected by the organizers must provide for their own conditions of stay, hotel reservations, meals and special transfers.

A direct transfer by coach can be available from the international airport Mohammed V of Casablanca in direction of El Jadida. To make the request with the sending of the engagements of horses, and to indicate there the number of persons, the provenance, the arrivals schedules and the flight numbers.

In order to facilitate the search for the amenities during the stay of each participant or companion, the TERRATOUR Agency will be able to assist the various applicants for services.
